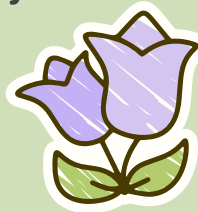

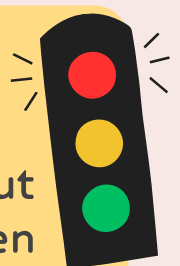
THIS MONTH'S ACTIVITIES

Pizza Day

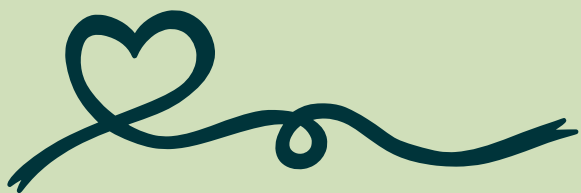


The students joined a lively pizza-making session that made learning enjoyable and practical. It encouraged teamwork, improved communication skills, and brought excitement to their day.
